**Keyboards**



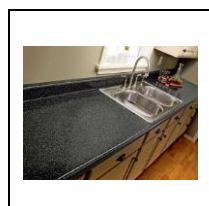
**Bin lids**

**Booking in systems. Public Pens.**



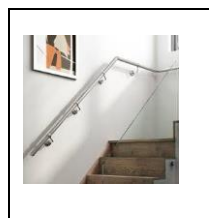
**Hot desks**

**Kettles**



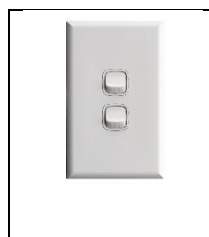
**Bannister and handrails**
